

TREE No 2b - MICKLETHWAIT OF KENT, LONDON, BEESTON HALL, COLTISHALL HALL & TAVERHAM HALL NORFOLK, COOKLEY SUFFOLK & IRIDGE PLACE, SALEHURST, SUSSEX, ENGLAND.

John Micklethwait (1719-1799) was 6th in descent from Sir William Micklethwait Knt. of Ingelthorpe and Kingtonhoe, Co. York - ancestor of Viscount Micklethwait. (SOURCE: Burke's - The General Armory of England, Scotland & Wales)

A monument in Birchanger Church in Essex carries the following inscription - Near this place lie in Hopes of a joyful Resurrection the Remains of JOHN MICKLETHWAIT ESQ. of Beeston St Andrew in the County of Norfolk, Died 27 February 1799. Aged 79 years. Descended from the ancient family of Micklethwait of Swine in the County of York.

PLEASE NOTE: The Rev Thomas Micklethwait & his wife Beatrice (shown below) are also shown on the Worsborough Dale branch. (Source: London Visitation Pedigrees 1664 mentions the Micklethwait Coat of Arms that was originally confirmed to the family in Yorkshire in 1626. This proves that the Southern Branch were descended from the Original Yorkshire branch).
